O le 'auga o lenei tusi, 'ia tuuina atu ni faamatalaga taua e fesoasoani mo le malupuipua o tagata Samoa o lo'o alala i totonu o Niu Sila mai le pule i le ola. O lo'o aofia i totonu o lenei tusi ni mafua'aga o le ono faatupula'ia o lenei faafitauli, faatasi ma auala talafeagai e ono puipuia ai se tasi mai le pule i le ola. E i ai le faamoemoe o le a talafeagai ni vaega o lenei tusi ma finagalo, lagona ma soifua o nisi o o tatou tagata.

Talu ai 'ona e le 'o tele ni faamaumauga e faasino i le Pule i le Ola mo tagata Samoa, o lea ua a'e ai se tofa ina ia avea lenei tusi ma tusi fa'atupu lagona, ina 'ia u'una'ia ai se masaniga lelei o le faatalatalanoaina o lenei mataupu i totonu o aiga, nu'u ma faalapotopotoga.

## Faatinoina o le Tusi

Sa fa'atinoina e le susuga ia David Lui ma le susuga ia Magnum Tuipulotu ni fonotaga ma tagata Samoa i pitonu'u 'eseese o Niu Sila, e aofia ai Dunedin, Christchurch, Porirua ma Aukilani. O le sini o nei fonotaga, ia faatalatalanoaina ma sailia ni o latou finagalo fa'ataua i le mataupu o le Pule i le Ola, atoa ma auala pito talafeagai mo le tusiaina o lenei tusi. O le tusi e le 'o se faaliliuga mai se tusi faaperetania e pei ona iai nisi tusi i taimi ua mavae. Peita'i ua tusia lenei tusi e faavae sa'o mai lava i talitonuga, o tu ma aga faa-Samoa sa soalapuleina i fono sa faagasolo i Niu Sila e pei ona ta'ua i lugua.

## O ai e talafeagai i ai?

So'o se tasi lava e galue ma o tatou tagata i totonu o Niu Sila e pei o: Foma'i, Faia'oga, Faife'au, Ta'ita'i, i latou e galulue i totonu o so'o se auaunaga a le Soifua Maloloina, aemaise latou o lo'o auauna i Matagaluega o Gasegase o le Mafaufau. E tatou ona faaogaina lenei tusi faatasi ma isi tusitusiga ma taiala, ua uma ona tusia mo le puipuia o tagata mai le Pule i le Ola.



O le *Fa'a-Samoa* ma le *Fu'amatai* e faavae ai so'o se fa'alapotopotoga, aiga, nū'u ma le atunuu, o talitonuga, o tu ma aga i fanua. O finei foi e afua mai ai le tulaga o le tagata, ma lona faasinomaga, atoa ma lona faiā ma isi.

## Pule i le Ola i totonu o Samoa

I le vaitaimi e amata mai i le faai'uga o le 1970 se'ia o'o atu i le 1990 sa va'aia ai le faateteleina o tagata e Pule i o latou soifuā i totonu o Samoa, pe a fuaufa i isi atunu'u o le lalolagi, aemaise lava talavou i le va o le 15 ma le 24 tausaga. O se vaega to'atele o e na pule i ola ma maliliu ai, e pogai mai le inumiaina o le vailau oona. O ia vailau oona sa aumaia i totonu o le atunu'u ma le faamoemoe e mo le galuea'iga o faatoaga. Ona o le matuia o lenei faafitaui o le pule i le ola, sa alia'e ai ni taumafaiga e faafaitagātāna ai le maua e tagata lautele o lenei vailau oona, ma o na taumafaiga, na faaititia ai le fuainumera o tagata e maliliu i le pule i le ola.

## Pule i le Ola i totonu o Niu Sila

E tusa ai ma faamaumauga; o lo'o ataata mai ai e ititi atu tagata Pasefika e pule i le ola, i lo tagata Maori ma tagata Papalagi.

Ae ui i lea, e pei ona faaalia i su'esu'ega ma ua faamaumauina i le ripoti, *Te Rau Hinengaro: The New Zealand Mental Health Survey*. E tele atu tagata Pasefika na faaalia, na fuaufa mautinoa e pule i le ola, ma tele atu fo'i ē na taumafai e pule i le ola i se taimi ua tuana'i, i lō isi tagatanuu o lo'o nonofo i Niu Sila. E toatele fo'i tagata Pasefika na mafaufau ogaoga o le a pule i le ola, i lo isi tagata vagana ai Maori e sili atu lo latou maualuga. Na ta'ua foi i lea ripoti, e sili atu le numera o tagata Pasefika na fananau i Niu Sila, na taumafai e le pule i le ola, i lō isi tagata Pasefika (18 tausaga pe sili atu fo'i) na malaga mai ma aumau i Niu Sila.



'O "Fa'alavelave" o se vaega o le olaga fa'a-Samoa e pei o le sijalofa ma isi fa'aaloalogia masani. Atonu ua mafatia ai nisi o tatou tagata Samoa i Niu Sila ma tete'e ai i le aganu'u fa'a -Samoa ona o le mamafa o saogamea ma le saputu mai o faalavelave




## Tulaga e ono mafua ai le Pule i le Ola

O nisi nei o mafuaaga e ono aafia ma faaosofia ai manatu o o tatou tagata e pule i le ola e pei ona faaalalia mai i fonotaga sa faatinoina, faatasii ma nisi faamaumauga e patino i lenei faafitauli:

- Gasegase o le mafaufau
- Faaletonu i le si'osi'omaga / alalafaga e nonofo ai
- O suiga i faavae ma le olaga faale-Aiga
- Faaletonu i fesoota'iiga
- Fa'alumaina i tauemuga ma upu faifai
- O agava'a totino o lo'o taulimaina ai faafitauli
- Faafitauli ögaöga i le olaga tuputupu a'e o se tagata

**Ma'i Aitu:** O le "fasia po'o le 'saua'" o nisi o gasegase faale-atunu'u ma o lo'o i ai fofõ faa-Samoa e togafitia ai. O aūga e tali-tutusa lava ma aūga o gasegase o le mafaufau. O nisi tagata Samoa ua aafia i nei gasegase ua le saili tagafiti i foma'i ne'i masalomia i latou i gasegase o le mafaufau pe togafitia sese fo'i.



## Aafiaga i Gasegase o le Mafaufau

O le gasegase o le mafaufau aemaisse lava fa'alogona le mautonu, ua mauluga lona fesoota'i atu i mafuaaga o le pule i le ola.


Ua faamaonia i totonu o Niu Sila e faapea, o tagata Samoa e aafia i gasegase o le mafaufau, ua sili atu lo latou faitau aofa'i (25.0%) nai lo tagata lautele (20.7%) i totonu o le 12 masina. O le isi popolega, ona e aupito itiiti ai lava le fuainumera o tagata Samoa e saili togafiti atu i Maota o Gasegase ma isi fa'alapotopotoga tau le Soifua Maloloina.

E talitonu Samoa (talu mai anamua) o le soifua maloloina lelei e ausia ina ua solosolo manuia ma maloloina le mafaufau, tino, agaga, ma fesoota'iga, i le va o le tagata ma lona si'osi'omaga. O gasegase o le mafaufau ma isi lava to'atuga o le tino, e mafua mai ina ua lē paleni ma le atoatoa se tasi o ia vaega e pei ona ta'u i luga.

O uiga le taualoa ma le le taupulea, e ono mafua mai ina ua solia e tagata le va tapuia i totonu o aiga, nu'u, po'o le va foi ma aitu/agaga o ē ua maliliu.

**Musu** – le fia fai mea. Ua avea ma mapusaga o se tasi pe'a feagai ma faafitauali ogaoga o le olaga.

**Tapu:** e faailoga ai le tua'oi o mea e taga ma mea ē sa. E i ai tapu e puipuia ai le va fealoaloa'i o tagata ma isi tagata, nu'u, si'osi'omaga atoa ai ma le va o tagata ma le Atua. O le solia o nei va tapuia e ono afaina ai le va lelei ma aafia ai le ola maloloina o le tagata.




## O le le Tagolima ma le Si'osi'omaga.

O le fa'aletonu o le tamāoaiga ma fale e nonofo ai tagata, e faateleina ai aafiaiga i faafitauli e aofia ai le Pule i le Ola. O le to'atele o tagata Samoa i Niu Sila, ua lē tagolima, ua vaivai le itū tau a'oa'oga, ma e maualuga foi le fuainumera o i latou e lē o faigaluega.

O le lē tagolima, ua avea ma mafua'aga o aiga lē mautu, ma ua lē atoatoa ai feso'ota'iga o 'au'aiga ma aiga potopoto. Ona o lea, ua lē maua ai e fanau na soifua a'e i totonusi o Niu Sila avanoa lelei e a'oa'oina ai ma olaina tu ma aganu'u fa'a-Samoa.

**Lagona le mautonu** – E ono tula'i mai pe a fa'aletonu feso'ota'iga ma mafutaga i totonusi o aiga. O le le mautonu, e ono mafua mai i lagona tu'uto'atasia ina ua leai se isi e alofa ane, ma e ono le fiafia e mafutatalanoa foi ma isi tagata. E aofia ai foliga ua matagitagigofie, le lelei se moe, ua le manogi fo'i se mea'ai. A o'o lava ina matua lē mautonu lagona ma ua leai se mautinoia ia te ia lava, e ono tutupu a'e ai lagona o le mana'o e pule i le ola.



## O Suiga i Fa'avae ma le Olaga fa'ale-Aiga



O le to'atele o tagata Samoa i totonu o Niu Sila, e lē o mautū ma maopoopo o latou aiga/aiga potopoto. Ua maitauina foi le toatele o aiga ua nā o le tinā po'o le tamā ma le fanau e aofia ai. O se tasi lea auala ua lē maopoopo ai nu'u ma ua faateteleina ai fe'ese'eseaiga i le va o tagata.

Ua lē maua e fanau na soifua a'e i totonu o Niu Sila le olaga na soifua a'e ai o latou matua i Samoa', o e sa faafaaileleina i totonu o aiga potopoto e ala i le faatinoina o tū ma aganu'u fa'a-Samoa. O le pogai lea o fe'ese'esea'iga i le va o matua na soifua a'e i Samoa ma fanau na soifua i totonu o Niu Sila.

O ia lava eseesegea ua lē saili fōfō atu ai fanau, ona o popolega ne'i lē malamalama le lautele i ò latou lagona ma manatu.

O tagata lē faaaloalo ma amio tū famua e lē tauleleia ma e ono faaesea ma le fia mafuta i ai se tasi.



## Fa'aletonu o Fesoota'iga



Ua faaletonu feso'ota'iga ma ua faateteleina talu ai, ua na o le gagana fa'a-Samoa e fesootai atu ai matua Samoa i a latou fanau; e ui o le fa'a-Peretania le gagana sili e malamalama lelei ai tamaiti.

O le isi tulaga ua atagia mai i suesuega ma finagalo faaalia o tagata Samoa i Niu Sila, o le vaivai o le tala i le tupe po'o le tamāoiga. Ua avea le taufai-faigaluega uma o matua, ua leai ai se taimi e mafuta faatasi ai ma fanau. O nisi ia o faafitauli o fesoota'iga i le va o aiga.

O le Pule i le Ola, o le iuga lea o le loto tīgā ma le lē fiafia, talu lagona ootia ua lē mafai e se tagata ona talanoa mai ai.

Ona o le loto tīga ma le faigata ona talanoa mai, ua le faigofie ai ona iloa atu ni foliga vaaia, ni uiga po'o ni aga e maitauina ai le ua fia pule i lona ola. O le tele o taimi, e foliga mai e pei e leai se mea o tupu . Peita'i, e matua faate'ia lava ina ua iloa mulimuli ane, ua pule i lona ola.

## Fa'alumaina i Tauemuga ma Upu Faifai


Afai o se faamoemoe patino ua lē taulau, po'o faamoemoega fa'a-le aiga ua lē mafai ona ausia, pe faia foi e se tasi se mea e faalumaina ai lona aiga, e ono avea ia mea ma tulaga e fa'apopoleina ma ta'uvalae a, ma taitaiina atu ai i mafaufauga e pule i le ola.

O le fa'alumaina ua faigatā ai ona fa'asoa mai ona logona mafatia; ma faapologaina ai i mafaufauga le tonu.

O le faalumaina fo'i ma upu faifai e fai i le tagata ua aafia i gasegase o le mafaufau, ua fai ma faalavefau tūgā mo le fofōina o lea gasegase. O le musu ina ne'i faalumaina, ua avea ma ala ua lē su'e fofō ai lē ua aafia, faapea fo'i ma le aiga, ina ia saili se fesoasoani.

E o'o foi i le aiga o se ua pule i lona ola lagona o le ma ma le faalumaina, ona o le tomanatu: Po'o ua lape 'ea le matou tausiga?, Po'o ua i ai ea se fa'aletonu i totonus o le matou lotoifale ua pogai ai lenei faafitauli matuia?

'E i ai le faaipuga fa'a-Samoa e faapea: "E sili atu le oti nai lo le mā". O le maasiasi, o le tasi lea mafuaga ua faigatā ai i tagata ona faatalatalanoa o latou faafitauli, ma ono fa'aosofia ai manatu e pule i le ola.




## E fulitua 'ese mai le Lotu



E lē gata i lea, o le talitonuga i le Atua, e avea o se puipuiga mai lagona fia pule i le ola e pei ona faaalalia mai e nisi sa o'o i lea tulaga. O le fulitua 'ese mai i talitonuga ma mafutaga faakerisiano, e ono fa'avaivaia ai se tasi ma manatu fa'atauvā'a ane ai ia te ia ma lona tamalii'aga.

O le Atua e "*Pule i le ola*" aua o IA na te aumaia le ola, o IA foi e na te toe aveesea. O le ola o le meaalofa a le Atua. O se na te faia se faai'uga e fa'amutaina lona lava soifua tua ta'uua o le "*flapule i le ola a le Atua*".

## O Agava'a Totino o lo'o taulimaina ai le Pule i le Ola

Ua ripotia mai e faapea o le ita o se mafuaaga autū o le pule i le ola. Ua talitonu nisi o omiga fa'ale'aganuu e fetineia'ina ai, faatasi ma faamoemoega mo fanau ua lē taulau, ua avea ma mafuaaga o le ita ma le tete'e o nisi o alo ma fanau Samoa i totonu o Niu Sila.

O le to'atele ua soifua a'e i Niu Sila, e lē atoatoa agava'a e mafai ona latou faaali atu ai se lē fiafia i matua ma aiga, talu ai le agaga fa'a-Samoa e faapea, o se lē aya i matua le faaali atu o ni manatu e 'ese mai ma o latou finagalo. O nisi talavou, ua lē tatalaina mai o latou manatu ona o le sauā po'o le lē malamalama foi o matua i o latou lagona ma le olaga fa'a-Niu Sila. Ona o lea, ua taofiofia ai e talavou le ita ma le lē fiafia i totonu, ma avea ma avega mamafa e taitaiina atu ai i lagona fia pule i le ola.


## Fa'asinomaga Taulagi

Ona o suiga ua i ai le lotoifale o aiga i Niu Sila, ma le fulitua 'ese mai o nisi o tatou tagata mai le Lotu, ua lē maua ai le fesoota'iga vavalalata ma isi. O le to'atele ua lē maua avanoa e olaina ai aga fa'a-Samoan moni ma le malamalamaga sa'o i vaega, e pei o le faatinoina o tiute ma le tautua matavela i aiga ma nu'u.

O nisi alo ma fanau Samoa i totonu o Niu Sila, ua pei ua omia fa'avaeluatai i tu ma aga; ua fememea'i i le tau faapaleniina o le olaga fa'a-Samoan moni i totonu o le siosiomaga fa'a-Niu Sila. O aga faapapalagi e pei o le manatu fa'apito i lona lava lelei, fia mauoa ma le poto fa'aonapo nei, ua feteena'i ma tu ma aga faa-Samoan o le galulue faatasi, fegalegalea'i, ola tautua ma le faamua-muaina o tiute i aiga ma ekalesia. *"E leai se aogā e tele ai au mea, ae leai ni ou aiga"* (faamatalaga a se tasi Samoa sa faatalanoainia).




## Tulaga Faigata o le Olaga





## O isi Tulaga o lo'o Saosaolaumea i le Pule i le Ola.

O le lofituina i le sapatu mai o le mau faafitauli, e faatupuina ai lagona o le fia pule i le ola.




## O le Aiga: O se puipuiga.


## Puipuiga e ala i le Ola Faaleagaga ma le Fa'asinomaga.


